### TRURO v. FALMOUTH CHURCH INSTITUTE.

Playing at Tremorvah, on Friday, Truro easily won the match with Falmouth, who, on going to the wicket first, were dismissed in about 30 minutes for a paltry 29. Half of this total was made by Broad, who was, however, missed twice before he fell to a catch by Jory, otherwise the score would not have reached 29, seven wickets being down for 6 runs. Peart and Jory captured five wickets for 7 runs and three for 17 respectively. With only 30 to win, Truro opened account as bad as the visitors. Their first three wickets all captured by Coward at a cost of 2 runs yielded only 9. Carlyle obtained two wickets cheaply, and half the side were out for 14. Then Bullen, who was missed off the first ball he received, became associated with Port, and the runs were knocked off without further loss. Numerous changes in the bowling were tried without effect, until Port was out for obstruction to Langdon for 19, the partnership with Bullen producing 73 runs. Vibart followed in, and stayed with Bullen until the latter had completed his century, but not before he had had another life at 96. The innings were then declared with 174 for the loss of six wickets.
