

1909 - Changes from Colin Munford 23/2/15

Pages 4 and 5 - to be consistent with other references, remove brackets around **2nd XI** for Surrey and Notts entries.

Page 6 - paragraph 3, line 9 - remove 'the' from "one delegate from the each of".

Page 12 - In H Barrett biography, capitalise 'Reading Cricket Club'.

Page 51 - In Notes section line 2, close gap between 1 and ½.

Page 56 - In Notes section line 3, add 'as' to "which as far as is known".

Page 58 - In Sources line 1, delete 'Newcastle Newspapers'.

Page 60 - In Sources line 2, delete 'a' after "South Wales".

Page 62 - Delete 'ground location' from Missing section as now identified.

Page 68 - In Sources line 2, replace '/' with ',' between 14 and 15 after Staffordshire Sentinel.

Page 74 - In Notes line 1, close gap between 58 and .4.

Page 80 - Colin had previously noted an anomaly between the 1909 book and CricketArchive where the bowler Wilson is shown as second bowler in the book and 4th on CA. Assuming the bowling came from the partial Devon scorebook, which is correct?

Page 90 - In Notes section line 2, add a 't' to make 'the' for "Boles took 11 wickets in **he** match for 78 runs"

Page 96 - Add 's' to "Source:". In Sources section line 1, delete 'Staffordshire Advertiser 7 August 1909'. In line 2, delete 'Cheshire Newspapers'.

Page 111 - In Notes section line 1, delete 'by' in "Wiltshire won **by** this return".

Page 121 - In Sources line 1, delete 'Cheshire Newspapers'.

Page 135 - The second last entry in Highest Team Totals should show the venue as 'Bedford **ES**'.

Page 140 - Change the number of entries after FIFTH WICKET to 3 not 2.

Page 144 - Most Maidens in a Match : first entry - change venue to 'Bedford **MS**'.

Page 145 - Last line on the page should show venue as 'Grimsby **LL**'.

Page 149 - In Missing Data section:

- Reduce the number of missing ground locations from four to three and delete match 31.
- Remove missing Captain
- Reduce the number of missing wicket-keepers from five to three and delete 'Match 99 (Wiltshire wicket-keeper v Dorset) and Match 100 (Hertfordshire wicket-keeper v Devon)'.

Page 150 - Add to Addendum section - "Page 184 the Surrey 2nd XI Secretary was W Findlay not W Findley".

Page 191 - Replace 'Bedfordshire' with 'Berkshire' in the line "Drawn – won on first innings: v Bedfordshire at Reigate".

Page 194

- Tony Webb had previously altered the number of matches played at Bedford Grammar School from 24 to 23 and the number at Bedford Modern School from 3 to 4. Pete - do you agree with this change?
- Add 'Road' after "Bedford - Bedford Modern School Ground, Clarendon".
- Against 8th wicket - change venue to 'Luton **WP**'.
- Against 9th wicket - Change J Butler to Butler J as given as a Pro in 1904 book.
