GLAMORGANSHIRE'S GOOD LEAD.

ATTRACTIVE BATTING IN MATCH WITH MONMOUTHSHIRE.

Result of corresponding match last year.—Monmouthshire, 435; Glamorgan, 121 and 187. Monmouthshire won by an innings and 127 runs.

The weather necessitated a delay of nearly an hour in the start of the two-days' fixture between Glamorgan and Monmouthshire on the Cardiff Arms Park on Wednesday. E. S. Phillips having won the toss, he and Silverlock opened the Monmouthshire innings. After Silverlock had scored 11, which comprised two boundaries, he was beaten by Nash. P. Rees, the incoming batsman, made some nice late hits, but run-getting was difficult, E. S. Phillips being more than forty minutes making double figures. With the total nearing the forties, a double bowling change was made, Maxwell displacing Nash, and Hacker going on for Creber in the next over. The wicket appeared to be easier after the luncheon interval, and runs came with more freedom. E. S. Phillips, when 27, had a life, when Symonds failed to hold a catch at square leg. P. Rees made several boundaries from Creber's deliveries, but the latter was recompensed when he beat Phillips with a splendid ball. With the very next delivery Robotham played on Diver averted the "lat trick," but he should have been run out when Nash failed to hold the ball from a throw-in. However, before he had broken his "duck" Maxwell caught him out. Rees was batting in bright fashion, and soon reached the half century. T. B. Williams, after scoring 9, was bowled by Nash, and before the score had been augmented W. E. C. Hudden also succumbed to the Cardiff pro. The innings shortly afterwards closed for a total of 123, Rees carrying out his bat for a much-needed 68.

Norman Richee and T. A. L. Whittington opened Glamorgan's innings. Both men batted with confidence, but when the former had a dozen runs to his credit he succumbed to a catch by Diver, off F. G. Phillips. Owing to slack fielding by Monmouthshire several hits which would have produced only 1 or 2 runs were on a few occasions increased. On one occasion, owing to bad throwing in, Whittington secured a 3. The batsmen did not arrive their good luck long, Sweet-Escott being caught from Silverlock's bowling. Bancroft, the new-comer, soon lost the Noath amateur, but on Hacker coming in the score was quickly augmented. The latter batted with confidence, and he had a good partner in Symonds. The Marthys man's innings was quite a feature of the day's play, but he eventually fell to a catch in the long field. The home county were in a strong position at the conclusion of play. Scores:—

AN INNINGS DEFEAT.

GLAMORGAN'S FINE VICTORY OVER MONMOUTHSHIRE.

Result of corresponding match last year.—Monmouthshire, 435; Glamorgan, 121 and 187. Monmouthshire won by an innings and 127 runs.

Splendid weather favoured the concluding stages of the Glamorgan v. Monmouthshire match on the Cardiff Arms Park on Thursday. The over-night wet outs for Glamorgan, A. Gibson and J. Bancroft, went to the wickets, and further strengthened the home county's position, and as a result of another useful score by Nash, which included five boundary hits, Glamorgan held a lead on the first innings of 187.

E. S. Phillips and Silverlock opened Monmouthshire's innings, but after the latter had only accounted for a brace he was run out. Frank Rees, who had survived all the bowling on the previous day, came in, but when he should have been caught by Whittington, who failed to hold an easy catch. However, when he had just passed 20 he was clean bowled by Nash. Robotham before he had scored fell to a splendid catch by W. J. Bancroft. Further disaster quickly befell Monmouthshire, E. S. Phillips being sniped at the wicket after a stay of fifty-one minutes for 20. Diver did not stay long, being stumped by J. Bancroft after only adding a couple. T. B. Williams showed a little confidence, and made some fair strokes.

On resuming after the luncheon interval Hudden had only scored a single when Symonds effected a beautiful catch. T. B. Williams, who was now accompanied by W. A. Williams, batted well, and hit two successive 4s off Creber. In the following over, however, he lost his partner, who was bowled by Nash, whilst a few runs later the Cardiff pro. caught F. G. Phillips from one of Creber's deliveries. Matters continued to go badly with the visiting county, T. B. Williams being the only batsman to show any tendency to avert the innings defeat, but, despite his splendid defence, he eventually succumbed to a catch behind the wicket. The tail end of Monmouthshire did not offer much opposition, and after a little over half an hour's play succeeding the luncheon interval Glamorgan had won handsomely. Complete scores and analysis:—
