MINOR COUNTIES' CHAMPIONSHIP.

CARMARTHENSHIRE v. DEVONSHIRE.

At Llandover yesterday, Devon won the toss and Lt. Wilson and Lieut. Harrison went in to face the bowling of Gravell and Gee. Runs came very freely, and with the score 40 Hugh Powell replaced Gravell. A little later Wilson was caught by O. T. Lewis off Gee with the score at 47. After knocking Howell for a 6 Harrison was out to the same bowler with the next ball. Light contributed a meritorious 83, and Hooman paired him partnership with Shelley when the score was exactly 100. Cyril Morgan then took up the bowling instead of Howell, and with his first ball best Davies, the score being 144 for five wickets at lunch.

On the resumption, Davies was smartly bowled by Cyril Morgan. Capt. Waller then went in to partner Sturt. After hitting 5 Sturt was lucky to be missed off the slip. He then hit Howell for 6, and in the succeeding over secured three 4's. His partnership with Waller was prolific, both players hitting out strongly. Sturt was eventually dismissed for 47, and a little later Waller was caught by Gee or Morgan for an admirable score of 78, which included eleven 4's and one 6. The Hon. D. Scott was the last to go in, and was dismissed by Gravell without scoring.

Hugh Powell and Lieut. Evans went in at four o'clock against the bowling of Gee and Gravell. Hitting consistently and taking no risks both players made a good stand. The first wicket fell at 76, when Howell was caught by Evans off Scott after turning up a pretty score of 46. Percy Rees then partnered Evans, and the latter hitting out strongly off the leg the former was unfortunately run out.
