GLAMORGAN v. DEVON.

The return match between Glamorgan and Devon in the Minor Counties Championship was commenced at Cardiff yesterday. The wicket was rather spongy after heavy rain, but still it played easily, and general surprise was exhibited when Gibson, after winning the toss, elected to put Devon in to bat. Devon made one change from the side that met Carmarthenshire, Captain Christian coming in vice the Hon. D. Scott, and in the home side Stapleton made his first appearance in a county engagement. Creber opened the bowling, and off the third ball sent down he failed to take a hard straight return from Wilson. Afterwards Wilson played delightful cricket, and monopolized the bowling, scoring 30 while Lieut. Harrison was getting 6. The first wicket fell at 43, Nash dismissing Harrison. Light sent up the half-century with a drive to the boundary off Hacker, but Nash gained his wicket at 66, play having been in progress exactly one hour. In his next over Nash hit down Wilson's leg stump, the retiring batsman having scored 42 in 66 minutes. Hacker spread-eagled Shelley's wicket with the first ball. With Hooman and Davies together the run getting slowed down. At 85 Maxwell relieved Hacker, and with his fourth delivery disposed of Hooman. Seven runs later Maxwell gained his second wicket, Cruwys playing late and being bowled. Further successes fell to the Swansea trundler, Sturt, Waller, and Tamworth all falling to him in two overs. At this point Maxwell had taken five wickets for 5 runs. With the score at 86 for nine the adjournment was made for lunch. With only a single added, on the resumption, Maxwell bowled Davies, the innings closing for 87. Maxwell took six wickets at an average of a run apiece. Glamorgan opened their innings at 2.45 with Norman Richea and E. R. Sweet-Escott. With only 8 on the board Sweet-Escott left, l b w in Christian. Maxwell took six wickets at an average of a run apiece.

RICHES IN GOOD FORM. Glamorgan opened their innings at 1.45 with Norman Riches and E. R. Sweet-Escot. With only 5 on the board Sweet-Escot left, lbw to Christian. The wicket was now playing very trickily, and the bowlers were getting a lot of work on the ball. At 21 Waller went on at the plantation end, vice Wilson, and was hit to the boundary in his first over by both Riches and Bancroft. The 50 appeared after thirty-five minutes' play. At 53 Christian crossed over, and Light's bowling was immediately lifted to the boundary by Riches. After making some good strokes, Bancroft was bowled in trying to drive Light. Stapleton did not make a long stay, being run out through a smart return by Hooman. Two full-tossed ones by Light were promptly hooked to the boundary by Riches, who reached his 50 after a stay of an hour. At 83 Wilson resumed in place of Light, Symonds never seemed comfortable, and after scoring 7 returned one to Wilson. Hucker sent up the century after play had been in progress ninety minutes, and then got Christian prettily away to leg for four. At 106 Riches fell to a beautiful ball from Wilson. His contribution of 59 included six boundaries. Hucker left at the same total, bowled by Christian. Cruwys mixed both Jack Bancroft and Maxwell off successive balls, but in the last ball of the same over he made amends by catching Bancroft from a lofty one. The remaining batsmen gave very little trouble, and Glamorgan were all out for 150.

MAXWELL'S FINE CATCH. Devon changed their order of going in in their second venture, Hooman accompanying Shelley to the wickets, Maxwell and Nash bowling. With only 14 on the board Maxwell finely caught and bowled Hooman. Two more wickets fell quickly, Light being bowled by Maxwell and Wilson being thrown out by Riches. With Harrison and Shelley together runs came at a rapid pace, and at 52 a double bowling change was tried, Creber going on at Maxwell's end and Hucker displacing Nash, whose bowling had been hit freely. The change had the desired effect, Hucker dismissing Shelley, who had batted freely for 29. Harrison and Sturt then made a stand, and carried the total to 88, when Sturt was smartly caught and bowled by Maxwell, who had relieved Creber, and in the next over Nash, who had relieved Hucker, bowled Harrison. At the close of play nine wickets had fallen for 109. Score:-

The remaining wicket added nine runs, and then Waller fell to a catch by Stapleton, off Nash, the innings closing for 111. Maxwell again came out with the best bowling, having four wickets for 56, and making his total bag for the match ten for 24. Stapleton and Sweet-Escot opened Glamorgan's second innings, Christian and Wilson taking up the attack. A glamorous start was made, the Plymouth (Merthyr) man being bowled by Christian before a run had been scored. W. J. Bancroft, who followed in, opened with a sisk through the slips for a couple, and then put Wilson twice to the boundary. The second wicket fell at 20, Bancroft falling a victim to a curly one from Light, who had gone on as the football end in place of Wilson. The wicket was playing very trickily, and runs came slowly, and the first hit of note was a hook to leg for 3 by Riches, off Christian. Afterwards, however, the pace improved, and the 50 went up after thirty minutes' play. Several boring changes were made, and at 62 Waller relieved Christian, who had scored down fourteen wickets for 11 runs. The wicket was now hit off without further loss.
