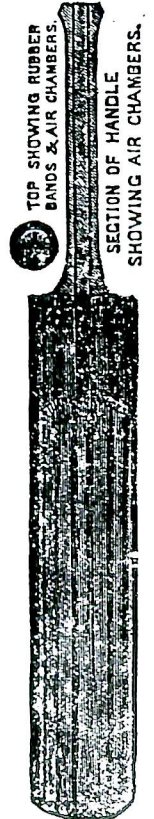

CRICKET.

Wilts v. Dorset.

This second-class championship match was commenced at Trowbridge on Monday, before over 100 spectators. The wicket played fairly easy for a time, and a good start was made, although several overs were bowled before Budge opened the score with a snick in the slips, which went perilously near to C. Awdry. The first wicket fell at 39, but although the home captain frequently changed his bowling the total at lunch was 90 for one. After lunch a great change came over the game. Newman, who had bowled 10 overs for three runs, best Arundel, and a collapse set in. Sewell was brilliantly caught low down in the slips one hand by Awdry. Williams was smartly stumped by Perkins, and the whole side was out for 143. Newman bowled in wonderful fashion, taking five wickets for 22, Mitchell having the other five for 72. The home team commenced none too well, the first wickets going down quickly, but the brothers Awdry scored freely. Both were favoured with some luck, but for all that they batted well, driving all along the carpet. R. Awdry and Perkins made the longest stand, putting on 61 before the latter was caught for a useful 29. Nicholson, the local favourite, followed, but the second ball he received got up and split his finger. He retired for Miller, but coming out again later on played a splendid innings, in fact the prettiest cricket of the day, and carried out his bat for 28. The innings closed for 217, a lead of 74—a winning lead. When play was resumed on Tuesday Dorset fared disastrously, losing the first three wickets for four runs. Sewell saved his side from absolute disaster, and W. Cummins hitting merrily the total reached 83. Newman and Mitchell again did the bowling, having five and four wickets for 39 each. The homesters only had ten to make, which were knocked off without loss, and they thus won by ten wickets. Scores:—
