**Beaten in a Day.**  
 Though Berkshire are facing so badly this season it cannot be attributed in any way to lack of enterprise on the part of the executive in making experiments. On Monday against Wilts the Rev. A. G. P. Baines, H. Brougham, S. H. Stevens and R. M. Farryman were all introduced with the hope that the county's bad luck would turn. No one could have expected the startling performance, for despite the excellence of the wicket Berkshire were all scuttled out in 18 overs for 88 runs, Mitchell and Smith carrying all before them—not a single Berkshire bat getting into double figures. Of course, Berkshire's position was practically hopeless after this, for though Wilts only made 240—thanks to some good bowling by Shoosmith and Farryman and some neat work in the field, Berkshire could not exceed 217 at the second attempt, and Wiltsie eventually won by 10 wickets. S. H. Stevens made a very satisfactory debut in hitting up 53, while Sir Charles Nepean made one of his usual scores "near the fifties."
