MINOR COUNTIES CHAMPIONSHIP.

BERKSHIRE v. BUCKINGHAMSHIRE.

The Bucks team to oppose Berkshire at Reading on Friday and Saturday last was more representative of the best cricketers in the county than before this season, with the result that the Berks team were easily beaten. A. W. Keen, the Rev. E. D. Shaw, E. A. Shaw, and E. West, members of the successful High Wycombe Club, were included, and one or two of them put up a capital performance. Bucks won the toss, and took full advantage of it, compiling the excellent score of 423, towards which number Dr. Weaver Adams contributed 162, his being a very fine display of batting. Later on A. W. Keen made the capital score of 79, which was compiled by fine forceful cricket, whilst Orton 50, West 32, and W. F. Lowndes 31 and the veteran Mat Wright 25, were in good scoring mood. The Berks innings was a very even display, only two men failing to obtain double figures. One of these was the Rev. A. G. P. Baines, formerly of Wycombe. Captain Rowe's 66 was the best innings for Berks, who made 314, and had to follow on. In the second venture Berks saved the single innings defeat by 77 runs, but Bucks easily hit these off for the loss of two wickets. Scores:—

This match, which was in the Minor Counties' Championship, closed the Berks Cricket Club season, which has been one of the worst on record. Home and away matches have been played with Surrey II., Bucks, Dorset and Wilts, and Berkshire has failed to secure a victory in either. The County XI. has not come up to expectations, and the loss of Cave and Hayward, through injuries in the early matches, proved disastrous. Next year, with several good cricketers properly qualified, the County should greatly improve its position.

Bucks Successful.

There were hopes at one time that Berkshire would make a strong fight against Bucks, for though the latter put up a score of 428 in their first innings—thanks partly to the big score of 102 by Dr. Weaver Adams—Berkshire gallantly responded with 214, or only 109 behind. It was curious after this that there should have been so many failures in the second innings, the total reaching only 78. Thus Bucks were only set 78 to win, and these were obtained for the loss of two wickets. It was in bowling that Berkshire were again weak. Simpson was not so successful as usual, but Shoosmith had 8 for 70 in the first innings. Most of the Berkshire men got some runs, either in the first or second innings. Captain F. H. Howes with 64 and Shoosmith with 50 being top scorers, while T. M. Hunt was not once out with 64. The present has been a disastrous season for Berkshire, every match having been lost except one, which was abandoned, but I understand that next season the Royal County is likely to be much stronger, both in batting and bowling.
