- R.W. Smithson. First played regularly, 1955. Appointed Captain, for 1959 season. Best season 1955 460 runs av. 51.11. Fine all rounder for Durham School, 1946. Represented Minor Counties v Australians, 1956.

- S. Crump. Off Spin Bowler. Debut 1930. N. Staffs League professional for many seasons. Father of B. Crump of Northants.
- R. Deville. 1959 was First full Season. 224 runs av. 32.
- J.M. Ellesmore. Pace Bowler. Debut 1957. In 1959 took 34 wkts, av. 19.58. Professional to Bignall End. 1960.
